Remit

- To make recommendations to full Council on all matters relating to Highways and Footways within the Town
- To consider and to make recommendations on any issues relating to Highways and Footways as instructed by full Council
- To liaise with other responsible authorities (Sedgemoor District Council, Somerset County Council) on matters relating to Highways and Footways within the Town, or in the general locality, where any proposals may impinge upon the Town
- To implement necessary changes as required by the Council in conjunction with relevant authorities
- To provide to full Council written minutes of all Advisory Committee meetings to form part of the public record
- Where appropriate to produce written reports and recommendations for consideration by full Council
